CHAPTER 130: GENERAL PROVISIONS

Section

130.99 Penalty

§ 130.99 PENALTY.

(A) Any person who shall violate the provisions of § 131.01 shall, upon conviction, be fined not less than \$10 nor more than \$200 for each offense.

(B) Any person who shall violate any of the provisions of § 132.01 shall, upon conviction, be fined not less than \$5 nor more than \$500 for each offense.

(C) Any person, firm, or corporation who shall violate the provisions of § 133.01 shall, upon conviction, be fined not less than \$10 nor more than \$200 for each offense.

CHAPTER 131: OFFENSES PERTAINING TO PROPERTY

131.01 Trespassing upon village water tower

§ 131.01 TRESPASSING UPON VILLAGE WATER TOWER.

The climbing on the village water tower and defacing or vandalizing of any village property is prohibited.

CHAPTER 132: OFFENSES AGAINST PUBLIC ORDER

Section

132.01 Smoking in public places and retail stores prohibited

§ 132.01 SMOKING IN PUBLIC PLACES AND RETAIL STORES PROHIBITED.

(A) Smoking or carrying of a lighted cigarette, cigar, or pipe is prohibited in theaters, public passenger elevators, public conveyances carrying 10 or more passengers, places of public assembly and retail stores, excluding areas set apart for serving food or beverages, waiting and rest rooms, beauty parlors, barber shops, executive offices, and other rooms or areas where merchandise is not exposed.

(B) In each of the places of business or places where smoking is prohibited, no smoking signs shall be posted by the proprietor in conspicuous places. The signs shall read: No Smoking - in the Interest of Public Safety, Smoking Is Forbidden in this Area by Forsyth Village Ordinance.

(C) The Chief of the Fire Department, or any member of the Fire Department assigned by the Chief, shall have the authority to enter into and inspect any of the places of business for the purpose of determining compliance with this section.

CHAPTER 133: WEAPONS

Section

133.01 Prohibiting use of firearms

§ 133.01 PROHIBITING USE OF FIREARMS.

The discharge, firing, and use of any shotgun, rifle, pistol, revolver, air gun, sling shot, bow and arrow (except as provided in Chapter 94), pellet gun, or other device capable of projecting a missile within the village is prohibited.
